TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- All plaques are individually numbered and details will be kept in State and National Registers.
- Vehicles receiving a plaque must be 100 years old and manufactured not later than December 31, 1918.
- The Veteran Car Club of Australia (Victoria) is responsible for determining, assessing and identifying the eligibility of the vehicle covered by this application.
- The recipient of the plaque must acknowledge that the plaque “belongs to the vehicle” and if the vehicle changes hands, then the plaque is to go with the vehicle.
- Each eligible vehicle can only receive one plaque. In the exceptional circumstances of a plaque being lost or stolen, the owner or custodian at the time may apply for a replacement, stating the circumstances of the loss. The Veteran Car Club of Australia (Victoria) will then make a decision on whether the plaque will be replaced.
- Only the year and make of the vehicle will be inscribed on the front of the plaque. Any additional inscribing, such as engine and chassis number and owner name at the time of presentation, will be inscribed on the rear of the plaque.
