Henry Ford was hell bent on breaking the land speed record in his '999' car – and undeterred from a set-back a few days earlier, set a record of 91.37 mph on the frozen lake. 'Humped over' the steering mechanism, and with no goggles or protection over his face, the determined Henry Ford set the record, which lasted just two weeks until William K Vanderbilt shaved .4 of a second off the time. Today, the world land speed record is 763.035mph and an Australian, Rosco McGlashan, who already holds the Australian land speed record of 500mph, is preparing to tackle the world record with his Aussie Invader. If you have a few minutes, check out Rosco's website and you will see he's a man on a mission.

Every year the Dry Lakes Racers Australia hosts Speed Week at Lake Gairdner in South Australia – it's one of only a few places in the world where you can drive flat out on a salt lake for twelve miles. This year from March 12 – 16, cars, motor bikes and trucks will come from all over Australia and the world to this amazing and unique location to try and go as fast as they can.

Check out the website www.dlra.org.au. As a 'veteran' enthusiast, I thrill to what has been achieved over the past hundred years.

The RACV Australia Day Festival on January 26 at Kings Domain, will see our Club join with other invited car clubs to display fifty cars of interest on this popular day.
