Rally to the Mallee Entry Cap of 200 has been reached. ENTRIES ARE NOW CLOSED

In less than 2 weeks, the 200 entry (400 people) quota was filled. It's obvious that a symptom of coronavirus is itchy feet in veteran vehicle owners. "I don't care where it is... I am going.!"

Until August 23rd, there is little for you to do except work on your car or bike to ensure it is ready for October. We, on the other hand, now have a rally to organise.

In early days, we established some priorities and a vision for this event:

- To run a COVID safe event.
- To create an event with a National rally feel (this is not just a local run).
- To keep queues, delays and bottlenecks to a minimum.
- To provide opportunities to show off our cars and engage the public.
- To ensure plenty of time to mix and mingle (at 1.5 metres) with friends, both old and from other states.
- To minimise the cost while providing a quality event.

Functions and activities have been planned with these priorities in mind.

In spite of the restrictions that coronavirus safety dictates, 200 veteran vehicles and 400 enthusiasts together will create a spectacle rarely seen in Australia.

However, compromises and concessions will be necessary. For some activities we will need to divide the group and head off in different directions. On these days we will rotate groups within groups, to ensure you are not just travelling with the same people each day. We have developed a system to make this simple, but more importantly, seamless to entrants.

The onus will be on you to make this all work.

RULE NO 1: Read and follow your Rally Book. It has been produced for YOU

RULE NO 2: Do not just follow the car in front of you. He will be following HIS rally book (and if he is in front of you, he must be on the wrong road and is lost).

RULE NO 3: The Directors' word shall never be questioned.

Memorise these rules. They will be pounded into all entrants by the start of the rally. (With a smile.)
